During the ongoing research by the Research Vessel NATSUSHIMA on the collision between MSDF DDG ATAGO and a fish boat SEITOKU MARU, the object which was spotted and press released on February 26, 2008, has been retrieved by the Japan Agency for Marine-Earth Science and Technology (JAMSTEC; Mr. Yasuhiro Kato, President) under the direction of the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) at the request of the Ministry of Defense.



(1) Location : North Latitude 34.31, East Longitude 139.49 Water depth: 1,835m




