2. Workshop Agenda

Based on submitted abstracts, an updated workshop agenda will be available before the workshop and at the workshop registration desk.

3. Poster Preparation

We ask all participants to prepare poster presentations for display at the workshop. Poster sessions will be on Tuesday and Wednesday. A plenary session will be devoted to discussions on poster presentations.

The size of each poster must be 4ft x 4ft or smaller. All posters will be mounted on AGU-style boards (4ft H x 8ft W, 2 posters per board) using Velcro or push-pins.

You may consider printing your poster at a print shop in Kona:

(a) The cost of printing a colored poster of 4ft x4ft on sign vinyl material is \$113.54.

(b) You can send your pdf file to Let's Go Banners (www.LetsGoBanners.com) before the workshop. They will print and deliver the poster to the hotel. Depending on the number of requests from the workshop, they may need to receive your poster file several days in advance.
